Orland Fire Protection District Residential Knox Box Loan Program

The Orland Fire Protection District has established a Residential Knox Box Loan Program for citizens of the Orland Fire Protection District. The objectives of this program are to expedite the paramedics reaching the patient and to minimize or eliminate damage to property by forcible entry.

Residents meeting the following criteria are eligible for the program.

1. The Knox Box can only be used for an Orland Fire Protection District resident living within the Fire District.
2. An individual with an existing medical or physical condition which could render him/her unable to open a locked door in an emergency situation.

Obtaining a Residential Knox Box

The department has a limited supply of Residential Knox boxes available for this program. To obtain one, the following procedure must be followed:

1. Individual must meet the existing condition criteria.
2. Contact the Fire District at (708) 349-0074 to determine if a Knox box is available and to make an appointment to pick it up.
3. Fill out the form and sign. Deposit of \$149.00 required.
4. Payment of deposit is due at time of Knox box pick up (Make checks payable to **Orland Fire Protection District**).
5. Bring the required residence keys to the Fire District when picking up the Knox box.
6. Complete a special needs form with current medical information.
7. Install the Knox box appropriately on the main entrance door.

If all Knox boxes are in use, the Fire District will make arrangements for you to purchase one. If you choose to purchase a Knox box, upon completion of its use the Fire District may option to purchase it from you.
