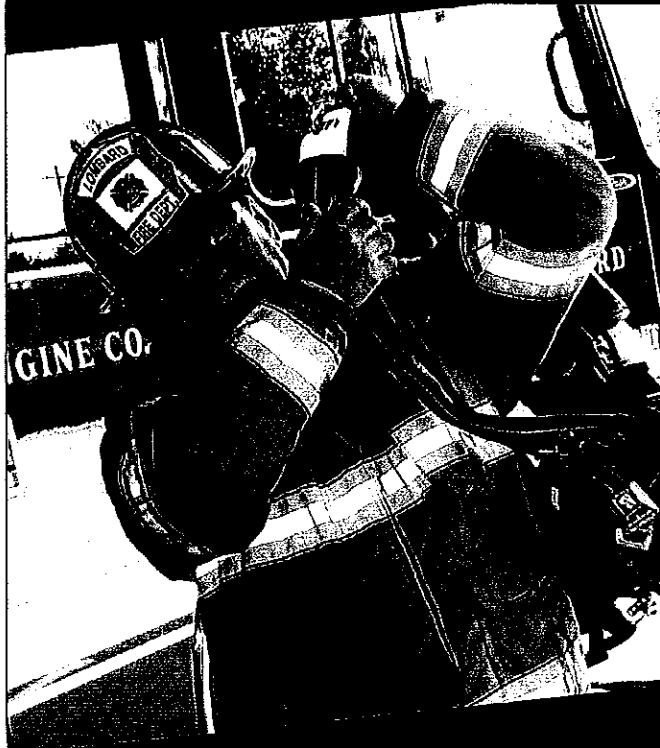


GIVING *and* RECEIVING:
