Program Overview

Our pilot Junior Cadet Program is being offered this year as a one day class on Monday, July 16, 2018. This class will be offered to children between the ages of 13 -15 years old. This class will give students a glimpse of an opportunity to explore Fire Rescue & EMS.

This class will provide a combination of classroom and side-by-side training with our current Cadets and Firefighters.

Summary

It is our aim that each Junior Cadet will leave this day with a better sense of responsibility and that he/she will be more accountable for their actions in their family and their community. We hope that by exposing the Junior Cadets to the skills of firefighters and EMS and the rules that they must follow to achieve success, he/she will have a better idea about what it takes to become a successful individual in the future.
